COMMUNITY

Canajoharie New York, a village of approximately 3000 lies on the Mohawk River between Albany and Utica. Primarily a rural, middle class community, the village has several attractions uncommon in similar sized communities. These include a waterfront boat launch/docking facility, a fine arts gallery and extensive athletic facilities such as an Olympic sized pool and community fitness center.

Canajoharie High School is a comprehensive public high school serving Canajoharie, Palatine Bridge, Sprakers, Ames, Rural Grove and portions of Fort Plain New York. High school enrollment in 2009-2010 is approximately 370 students. The school offers state-of-the-art science labs, art and music studios, computer labs, athletic facilities and other resources.

R (Regents/college prep): 1.5 times final average

G (general and nonacademic): Final average

Grades are issued on a numerical basis. Grades below 65 are considered failing.
